Who can organize a diaper drive?

Anyone! Individuals, schools, faith communities, civic and social clubs, professional groups, businesses, and other organizations can sponsor a drive.

What types of diaper drives are there?

A drive can be a request for diapers in lieu of gifts at a birthday party or a simple collection box at your local business, to an online virtual drive - we can create a custom Amazon Wishlist specific your organization!

What products can we collect?

Our most urgent needs are size 4, 5, and 6 diapers, size 3T/4T & 4T/5T pull-ups, and baby wipes. We gladly accept donations of new or opened packages of baby diapers, unopened baby wipes, adult incontinence products, and children's board books.




Diapers, Wipes & Books Drive


